



## **Tarras Vineyards** ***The Canyon 2007 Pinot Noir***

### **VINEYARD**

Known as *The Canyon*, this vineyard is located high on the terraces of a Bendigo sheep station sharing spectacular views of the valley below. A sheltered, sun-trapped basin comprising wind-blown loess with traces of clay. Traditional Pommard and Dijon Pinot Noir clones of 5, 115, 667 and 777 are cropped low at 5 tonnes per hectare to ensure ripe, concentrated fruit flavours.

### **TASTING NOTES**

Lifted aromas of cherries and plums. Rich, ripe fruit with fine tannin integration make for a statement of Pinot Noir.

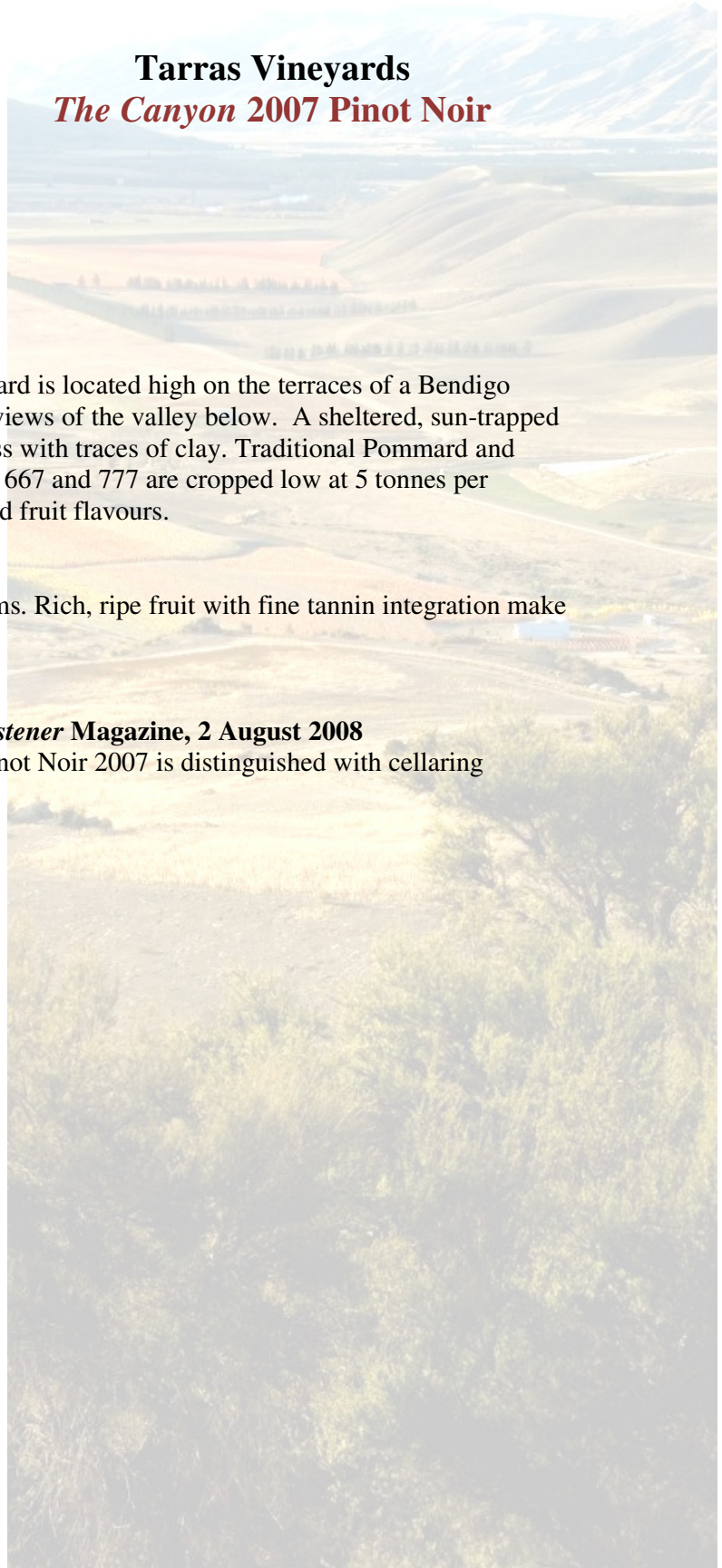
