TASTING NOTES – PINOT NOIR 2006

A single vineyard Pinot Noir hand picked from *The Canyon Vineyard* located high up at Bendigo in Central Otago. Lifted aromas of cherries and plums intermingle with hints of fresh Central Otago thyme and earthy, spicy, chocolate notes. Layers of fine, ripe tannins and fruit remain long after the wine has disappeared.
